



# The Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023









Consists of 44 provisions and penalties.

Uses "she/her" pronouns instead of "he/his".

Establishes The Data Protection Board of India for enforcement.



### Regulates Data Processing Across Borders

**Applicable** 

Within the territory of India

- in digital form, or
- in non-digital form to be later digitized

Outside the territory of India

When providing goods or services to Data Principals within India's territory



## Personal Data Processing Isn't Applicable When

Processed for personal or domestic purposes

Made publicly available by Data

Principals

A person is obligated under the law to make such personal data available.

## Navigate through the Definitions

#### Data Principal

The individual linked to the data;

- If a child, involves parents or guardians,
- For someone with a disability, their legal guardian.

#### **Data Fiduciary**

Someone who, alone or with others, determines how personal data is processed.

#### **Data Processor**

Any person processing personal data on behalf of a Data Fiduciary.

#### Significant Data Fiduciary

Data Fiduciary or class of Data Fiduciaries notified by the Central Government under section 10.

## Navigate through the Definitions

#### The Board

The Data Protection Board of India established by the Central Government under section 18.

#### **Consent Manager**

A registered person with the Board who facilitates Data Principals in managing their consent through an accessible, transparent, and interoperable platform.

#### Personal Data Breach

Unauthorized processing, accidental disclosure, acquisition, sharing, alteration, destruction, or loss of personal data compromising confidentiality, integrity, or availability.
